You must complete:

- 12 units for Part A
- 12 units for the Applied Finance field in Part B
- 8 units of electives from Part C

Students who receive an exemption for courses from *Part A* of the course list will be required to replace those courses with electives from Part B MIntEcon&F (#24) course list*

Students who receive an exemption from ECON7310 and/or FINM7401 from *Part B* of the course list will also be required to replace those courses with electives from Part B MIntEcon&F (#24) course list*

*excluding any courses which also appear on Part B or C of the MIEF/MCOM Dual Degree course list.

Students who receive an exemption for any of FINM7402, FINM7403, FINM7405 or FINM7406 (*Part B courses*) will be required to replace the course/s with an elective/s from Part C of the course list.

Students with more than three Exemptions (from Part B Applied Finance courses) must contact the School to confirm courses required to fulfil the Applied Finance field. The completion of ACCT7106 & FINM7407 will likely be required. If you are required to study ACCT7106 to fulfil the Applied Finance field of study for the dual degree program, please ensure you study the pre-requisite course ACCT7101 prior to undertaking ACCT7106 unless you have previously completed a course comparable to ACCT7101.
