## PROGRAM GUIDELINES

You must complete:

- 24 units for MIntEcon&F (32 units) Core Courses
- 8 units for MIntEcon&F Program Elective Courses

If Exemptions apply for Core courses, students are to undertake replacement Elective courses. With Head of School approval, a student may include 2 units for a level 7 course towards Electives.

The following is a suggested study plan only. There may be other ways to plan your progression through this program.

The study plan ensures pre-requisite courses are completed first. Students should not attempt courses where they have not completed the UQ pre-requisite(s) or an alternative comparable course completed at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

Students who wish to complete the #4 Thesis course as an Elective as ECON7930 (single semester) or ECON7933 (year-long commencing in semester 1) or ECON7934 (year-long commencing in Semester 2) should complete both pre-requisite courses prior to enrolling, i.e. ECON7310 Elements of Econometrics and ECON7950 Research Methods in Economics. Further information is available from the Course Profile (ECP).

Not all courses are offered every semester and/or every year. Check courses offerings prior to enrolling.
