### **PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

You must complete:

- 12 units for MIntEcon&F/MCom Core Courses
- 12 units for **Applied Finance** Field of Study Courses
- 8 units for MIntEcon&F/MCom Program Elective Courses

Students who receive an exemption for MIntEcon&F/MCom Core courses from the course list will be required to replace those courses with electives from the [MIntEcon&F \(24 unit\)](#) course list\*

Students who receive an exemption from ECON7310 and/or FINM7401 from the Applied Finance Field of Study of the dual program course list will also be required to replace those courses with electives from [MIntEcon&F \(24 unit\)](#) course list\*

\*excluding any courses which also appear in the Applied Finance Field of Study Course list.

Students who receive an exemption for any of FINM7402, FINM7403, FINM7405 or FINM7406 (*Applied Finance Field of Study courses*) will be required to replace the course/s with an elective/s from the MIntEcon&F/MCom Program Electives Course list.

**Students with more than three Exemptions (from Applied Finance Field of Study courses) must contact the School to confirm courses required to fulfil the Applied Finance field. The completion of ACCT7106 & FINM7407 will likely be required.** If you are required to study ACCT7106 to fulfil the Applied Finance field of study for the dual degree program, please ensure you study the pre-requisite course ACCT7101 prior to undertaking ACCT7106 unless you have previously completed a course comparable to ACCT7101.

The above study plan ensures prerequisite courses are completed first. Students should not attempt courses where they have not completed the UQ pre-requisite(s) or an alternative comparable course completed at undergraduate or postgraduate level.
