To be eligible to enrol in the **Master of International Economics & Finance** you must satisfy the entry requirements as outlined in the program rules for either the 2 year – (32 unit) program, or for the relevant discipline entry for the 1.5 year – (24 unit) program.

The following information is designed to help you plan your enrolment. Please note it is intended as a guide only; you should check the scheduling of courses each semester.

PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR 32 UNIT (2 YEAR FULL-TIME) PROGRAM

Complete 32 units comprising:

- 8 units for all [MIntEcon&F Foundational Courses](#), and
- 20 units for all [MIntEcon&F Core Courses](#), and
- 4 units from [MIntEcon&F Program Elective Courses](#)

PROGRAM GUIDELINES FOR 24 UNIT (1.5 YEAR FULL-TIME) PROGRAM

Complete 32 units comprising:

- 20 units for all [MIntEcon&F Core Courses](#), and
- 4 units from [MIntEcon&F Program Elective Courses](#), and
will receive Reduced Program Duration Credit for:
- 8 units for all [approved recognised prior learning](#)

If Exemptions apply for Core courses, students are to undertake replacement Program Elective courses.

The following is a suggested study plan only. There may be other ways to plan your progression through this program. The study plan ensures pre-requisite courses are completed first. Students should not attempt courses where they have not completed the UQ pre-requisite(s) or an alternative comparable course completed at undergraduate or postgraduate level.

Students who wish to complete the #4 Thesis course as an Elective as ECON7930 (single semester) or ECON7933 (year-long commencing in semester 1) or ECON7934 (year-long commencing in Semester 2) should complete both pre-requisite courses prior to enrolling, i.e. ECON7310 Elements of Econometrics and ECON7950 Research Methods in Economics. Further information is available from the Course Profile (ECP). **Not all courses are offered every semester and/or every year. Check courses offerings prior to enrolling.**

Core course only offered once per year in a standard semester: **Semester 2 only:** ECON7530
